Preparing Your Child for the School Year

Project LINK and the Back-2-School Coalition of Hillsborough County are proud to host the **28th Annual Back-2-School Health Clinics** to help families prepare their children for school enrollment requirements.

Our clinics provide school-entry health services designed to assist eligible students entering Kindergarten through 12th grade in Hillsborough County Public or Charter Schools.

Services Available

School Physical Exams

School physicals are available through licensed medical providers for students who require a physical examination to enroll in school.

A school physical may be needed if:

- Your child is entering a Florida public or charter school for the first time.
- Your child is transferring from another state or country.
- Your school has requested a current physical examination.

Routine Immunizations

Routine immunizations may be available for children who need vaccines to meet school enrollment requirements.

Vaccines help protect children from certain vaccine-preventable diseases and support compliance with Florida school attendance requirements.

A licensed healthcare professional will review your child's immunization history and discuss any recommended or required vaccines with you.

Parents and legal guardians always decide whether their child receives vaccinations.

Immunization Record Review

Our healthcare team can review your child's immunization records to determine whether they meet Florida school enrollment requirements.

Families are encouraged to upload their child's immunization records during registration to help reduce wait times and improve appointment efficiency.

Florida School Immunization Form (DH 680)

The Florida School Immunization Form (DH 680) is the official document used by Florida schools to verify a student's immunization status.

Clinic staff may assist eligible families with:

- Reviewing immunization records
- Updating immunization information
- Obtaining or updating a Florida DH 680 form when appropriate

Who Should Register?

Your child may benefit from Back-2-School Health Clinic services if:

- ✓ Your child is entering Kindergarten
- ✓ Your child is entering 7th Grade
- ✓ Your child is new to a Hillsborough County Public or Charter School
- ✓ Your child needs vaccines to meet school enrollment requirements
- ✓ Your child needs assistance updating immunization records or obtaining a Florida DH 680 form
- ✓ Your child requires a school physical examination

Important Appointment Information

Appointments Required

All services are provided by appointment only.

Walk-up services are not available.

Registration Fee

A one-time **\$10 administrative registration fee** is required per family account to reserve appointments for one or more children.

This fee:

- Applies once per family account (not per child)
- Supports appointment scheduling and clinic operations
- Is not a payment for medical services
- Is non-refundable

Save Time at Your Appointment

To help reduce wait times:

- ✓ Upload your child's immunization records during registration (*required for immunization or immunization records transfer/upload only appointments*)
- ✓ Bring any school forms you have received
- ✓ Arrive at your scheduled appointment time

Frequently Asked Questions

Are clinic services free?

Yes. Services are provided at no cost to eligible children. A \$10 administrative registration fee is required to reserve an appointment.

How long will my child's appointment take?

Most families complete their visit within 30 to 60 minutes. Visits may take longer when immunization records are unavailable or require additional review.

Can I bring my whole family?

Due to limited space and safety considerations, we recommend that only the parent or legal guardian and the child(ren) with scheduled appointments attend the clinic.
