



Back-2-School Health Clinic

Criteria Overview

Matrix outlining the qualifying questions and corresponding criteria for eligibility at the Back-2-School Health Clinics:

Qualifying Question	Criteria
School Physical Eligibility 1. Is your child new to Hillsborough County Public or Charter School?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Child must be enrolling in kindergarten. Child must be enrolling for the First-time in Hillsborough County Public or Charter School. Your Child eligible for a School Physical for enrollment purposes only.
Immunization Eligibility 2. Is your child up-to-date on CDC's recommended routine vaccines?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Child must be at least 5 years old enrolling in kindergarten or entering 7th grade this year. Child is coming from foreign county or not up-to-date on current vaccines. Child was previously under exemption status for routine vaccines. Your Child eligible for Routine Immunization appointment.
Immunization Record update Eligibility 3. Is your child's immunization record updated to the Florida Form DH-680?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Child transferring from a private school or a school outside of Florida and need form to enroll. Child is requiring vaccines due to enrolling in kindergarten or 7th grade. Child may be up-to-date on required vaccines, but need to have record transfer to Florida Form DH-680 Child's current immunization records are required to receive CDC scheduled routine immunization. Your Child eligible for Immunization Records Update or Transfer to Florida form DH-680.

Guidelines and restrictions for families seeking services at the Back-2-School Health Clinics.

Things to remember:

- Privately insured children are not eligible for services
- We do not offer VPK, Head Start, or Sports Physicals.**
- We do not offer annual physicals for children. Must contact primary care physician.
- Parents can contact their State Health Department to request immunization records or contact their child's current or last primary care physician.
- Exemption forms can be acquired by contacting the **Florida dept. of Health (813)307-8077**
- We cannot offer routine immunization or immunization record updates without a current immunization history form.
- We do not accept walk-ups at any location.** Our services are by Appointment ONLY.
- Appointments must be made online at www.b2shc.org. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- If your child does not currently have health insurance, we encourage you to explore your options for affordable coverage.
